

# 2020 Rules for voting

## Explanation

The 2020 Hindsight Concert(s) will be comprised of selections from SCB concerts from the Fall of 2007 up to the present including cancelled concerts. Current members will select their favorite pieces from the CONCERT LIST according to the guidelines below.

## VOTING: RULES

Current members have been organized into FOUR groups based upon their original year of membership (see listing)

Group A is comprised of members who joined prior to Fall of 2010 (20 members)

Group B is comprised of members who joined from Fall of 2010 to the Spring of 2013 (14 members)

Group C is comprised of members who joined from the Fall of 2013 to the Spring of 2016 (11 members)

Group D is comprised of members who have joined since the Fall of 2016 (26 members)

Based on the year of membership, long time members will have more votes and I will ask that they adhere to the suggestion below that some votes are limited to specific years

Group A members are able to vote for 10 selections, 5 of those MUST be on selections from 2007 to 2013

the remainder can be used anywhere.

Group B members are able to vote for 8 selections, 3 of those MUST be on selections from 2010 to 2016

the remainder can be used anywhere.

Group C members are able to vote for 6 selections, 2 of those MUST be on selections from 2013 to 2016

the remainder can be used anywhere.

Group D members are able to vote for 4 selections, from 2016 to present

You DO NOT need to use all of your votes.

When voting, include YOUR NAME on the form.

List all of the titles that you have chosen (arrangers are not necessary)

The concert program(s) will be determined by vote totals within the FOUR categories, so longtime members need to consider their early choices very carefully. The

program(s) will be a balance of selections from the FOUR categories.

### **REFRESH YOUR MEMORY**

Most of the selections on the CONCERT LIST can be found on Youtube. Be sure to include the correct composer or arrangers name when listening to a selection
